Navajo Tribal Utility Authority Selects Industrial Evolution for Reporting Solution

NTUA needed a solution to meet DOE reporting requirements

NTUA supplies and extends electricity, natural gas, water, wastewater treatment, renewable energy and telecommunications (including wholesale transmission of voice, data, graphics and other information) services to homes and businesses throughout the 27,000 square mile Navajo Nation and neighboring communities.

This project recommended to NTUA an architecture for automated reporting that meets the Department of Energy requirements for NTUA's approximately 39,400 electric customers, 36,600 water, 13,600 waste water customers, 7,900 natural gas customers, and 193 photovoltaic customers. The recommended solution will integrate several aspects of NTUA's SAP Enterprise Resource Planning system, the Elster Meter Head End System, and their real time OSIsoft PI System.
