### **ExxonMobil Corporation Receives Live Data Feed from Hadrian South Using Well\*Share™**

*Well\*Share meets the distinct needs of each party in this Oil & Gas production Joint-Venture*

ExxonMobil Corporation, the world's largest publicly traded international oil and gas company, is operator and co-owner of the Hadrian South field situated in about 8,000 ft of water in the Gulf of Mexico. Natural gas from Hadrian South is processed through the nearby Lucius truss spar floating production facility operated by Anadarko Petroleum. Production data from Hadrian South will be collected by Anadarko on systems installed on the spar.

ExxonMobil Corporation has entered into an agreement with Anadarko and Industrial Evolution to receive a live feed of the real-time data associated with Hadrian South production using Well\*Share.

Well\*Share is a web-based Data-as-a-Service (“DaaS”) solution that collects relevant data from an operating company according to their data and security standards, and serves it to their partners according to each partner's own individual data and security standards without any direct connection between the systems and networks of each company. Well\*Share has been in operation since 2001 and is used by many oil and gas companies including 14 out of the largest 15 in North America and Europe.

Founded in 2000, Industrial Evolution was an innovator in offering Data-as-a-Service to the industrial market. We collect real-time process data from systems and devices, and make it available securely via the internet.
